My Dear People of the Parish of St. Mark,

I am happy to report to you that the workers have finished putting up the stucco on the outside of the parish hall, facing the Legacy Good Samaritan park. I have included only one photograph this week: the finished product! After the stucco was complete, Bruno, the window sill craftsman returned to touch up his work. Now we move on to the parish hall roof - the project that your vestry actually set out to tackle several months ago! If today's weather is any indication of what is to come, it looks like we are getting to it just in time.

It has been a bit of a roller coaster ride with my brother-in-law David this week. On Sunday they had to start feeding him with an IV because it has been a week since he was able to eat. He was aspirating so they did a CT scan to see if he has pneumonia. That test came back negative, but they sedated him in order to let his body heal. Today we got word that the doctor found a spot on his liver that he fears spread from the colon cancer which they operated on to remove last year. Addressing that will have to wait until the current issues have been dealt with. An additional challenge is that David is normally on a number of medications which he has not been able to take since his bowel surgery nearly two weeks ago. That is complicating matters as well. Please continue to pray for him.

My parents have invited me to Madras for the Labor Day weekend, so the parish office will be closed on Monday and Tuesday. Please contact me on my cell phone in the event of a pastoral emergency. I pray that you all will have safe travels whether you are headed to the beach or just a backyard barbecue. Please pray for those who "labor" and work to make this country the wonderful place it is. I wish you all a blessed Labor Day!
