**November 30, 5 pm: Advent Lessons & Carols** featuring Cantores in Ecclesia and our clergy. We are so fortunate to have this world-class choir working in partnership with our clergy to present a beautiful mix of music and lessons for the season. **December 5, 7:30 pm: Rose City Renaissance concert.** GOTHIC TREASURES - ADVENT IN EARLY TUDOR ENGLAND, a program of late medieval and early renaissance sacred vocal music. This program will feature plainchant from the Sarum Rite, hymns, motets, and mass movements by English composers dating from 1300-1550. Through pre-Reformation works by John Taverner, Robert Whyte, Robert Fayrfax, and Thomas Tallis, listeners will experience a musical journey from the evening of All Saints through to Christmas Day. Polyphony in England during this period was uniquely ornate, florid, and extravagant with no equivalent on the continent. **December 7, 2 p.m. The Grant High School Royal Blues Holiday Concert.** Get into the spirit of Christmas with the youthful, but strong voices of this elite choir.
