EPIPHANYTIDE

Epiphanytide is the season of the Church Year immediately following Christmas. It commemorates the Adoration of the Magi and lasts from the Feast of Epiphany until Candlemas on February 2, just a few weeks before Ash Wednesday and the coming of Lent. One old tradition of Epiphanytide is Chalking the Door, when families chalk crosses on their lintels and doors much as the Children of Israel marked their doors with blood during the Egyptian Captivity as recorded in Exodus. Much as the Three Wise Men followed the Star to Bethlehem so too we as Christians are reminded to follow Christ in our own lives.

Support sacred music by attending a James O'Donnell concert. O'Donnell visited St. Mark's in May 2024.

One of the world's most distinguished church musicians, Mr. O'Donnell served for 23 years as Organist and Master of Choristers at Westminster Abbey. During his tenure, he directed music for some of the most significant national events in recent British history, including the wedding of The Prince and Princess of Wales and the 2022 funeral of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

Mr. O'Donnell will also accompany Cantores in Ecclesia on Sunday, January 25, for a Dominican Rite High Mass commemorating the Anniversary of the Dedication of Holy Rosary Church.
